Our students and graduates accomplished many great things in 2015
and we are excited about their futures!

- Overall, CWJC served a total of **216** women this past year in the Huntsville/Madison County area through our resource referral services, job-readiness classes, mentoring program, continuing education classes, Microsoft Word Certification Prep classes, and career clothes closet.
- **68** students received services this year in the classroom phase of our spring and fall programs.
- **25** students from 2014 continued to receive our services as they took part in the mentoring program.
- **28** Computers were given to our graduates. When we purchased new computers for the labs at two of our sites we were able to give our students the old computers. A donated computer provides the means for a graduate to continue to practice newly acquired computer skills, complete coursework for college or vocational training, and search for a job. We currently have a waiting list of **16** graduates who are eligible for a computer.
- All of our students received instruction in Microsoft Office at no cost. **21** hours of computer instruction in Word, PowerPoint, and Excel would cost approximately **\$800.00** each in a similar continuing education program
- **2** vehicles were donated, which will be given to 2 graduates in 2016, allowing them to have reliable transportation to school and work.
- **68** Bibles were given to students.
- **66** of our graduates and others in the community were given countless articles of clothing from our career clothing closet. **Our clothes closet is for anyone in our community with a need.**
- **31** students participated in the volunteer internship component, gaining important job skills and obtaining good references for pursuing future employment.
- **7** students were enrolled in college, certification, or vocational training this year.
- **60%** of our students who graduated in **spring of 2015** are employed. Of that number, **36%** were hired for a new position or their work hours increased. **68%** of our students who graduated in **fall of 2015** are employed. Of that number, **47%** were hired for a new position or their work hours increased.
- We had **5** who attended our QuickBooks class in June, providing them with a foundation in accounting software.
- All of our students were shown that God desires a personal relationship with them and that He has a plan for their lives!
