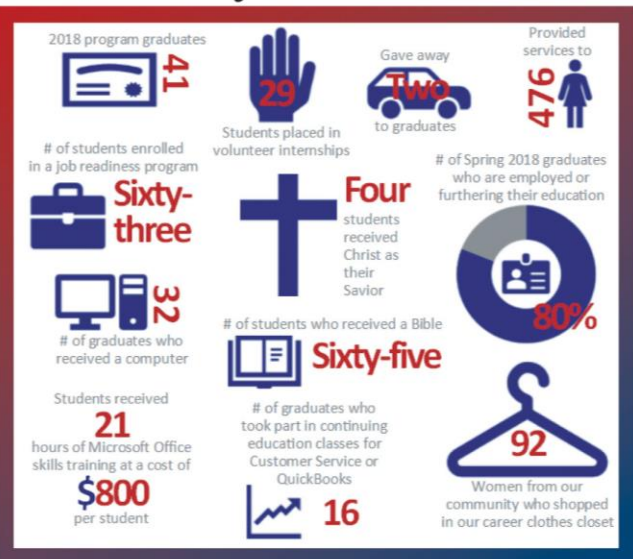

CWJC of Madison County was founded in 1998 and has been operating for over 20 years, serving women ages 18 - 60 from Madison County and surrounding counties. CWJC was created to address the needs of women from a wide variety of backgrounds and educational levels who need help to reboot or restart. The program offers that help through classroom instruction, internship positions, and mentoring. Classes are offered at no financial cost for students.

Our participants are primarily interested in entering the job market for the first time, re-entering a career after a lengthy absence, obtaining better employment, or furthering their education. This organization is not about hand-outs - it's about helping families get back on their feet.
